Abstract

This is template definition for the papers of the 9-th International Conference "Speech and Computer" SPECOM'2004, which will be held in Saint-Petersburg, Russia, September 20-22, 2004. This template aims at producing conference proceedings in electronic form.

1. Introduction

Information for full paper submission is available in the Internet web site of the Conference at <http://www.spiiras.nw.ru/speech/specom> in section "Submission", where you can find instructions for paper preparation and usage of templates.

2. Page layout and style

The page layout should match with the following rules. You can use a Microsoft Word template. Please, remember that paper must be submitted in PDF file only.

2.1. Basic layout features

- The camera-ready paper should not be more than eight (8) pages and must be written in English.
- Proceedings will be printed in A4 format, therefore, please, try to make your paper in A4 format.
- Two (2) columns with 10 mm space between columns should be used except for the title part and large figures that need a full page width.
- Right and left margins are 20 mm; top and bottom margins are 25 mm.
- The main text in camera-ready paper should be single-spaced.
- Do NOT include in the paper text any footers or headers (including numbers of pages)! They will be added in your paper automatically.

2.2. Headings

Section headings start at the left margin in 12 size point boldface with the first word capitalized and the rest of the heading in lower case. Sub-headings like major headings but not boldface. No more than 3 levels of headings should be used.

2.3. Text font

Times or Times Roman font is used for main text. Recommended font size is 10 points that is also the minimum allowed size. Other font types may be used if needed for special purposes.

2.4. Figures

All figures should be centered on the column (or page, if the figure spans both columns). Figure captions should follow each figure and have the following format "Figure1 . The main algorithm of the system".

Figures should be preferably line drawings. If they contain gray levels or colors, they should be checked to print well on a high-quality non-color laser printer.

2.5. Tables

The caption text must be placed above the table. The caption of each table should have the format "Table 1: The results of the system testing".

2.6. Equations

Equations should be placed on separate lines and may be numbered (not mandatory).

2.7. References

The reference format is the standard IEEE one. References should be numbered in order of appearance, for example [1], [2] and [3].

3. Conclusion

The paper should contain conclusion, which summarize essence of the described research.
